Christopher Holleman was appointed an Administrative Judge in the Small Business Administration's (SBA) Office of Hearings and Appeals (OHA) in 1995. He adjudicates the full range of cases before OHA, which include Size Appeals, NAICS Code Appeals, Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business Concern Appeals, and Economically Disadvantaged Women-Owned Small Business Concern Appeals. OHA will begin hearing Protests and Appeals from the Department of Veterans Affairs Center for Verification and Evaluation Database on October 1, 2018. Judge Holleman also serves as a Mediator, handling employee grievances and EEO complaints. Before joining OHA, he served in SBA's Boston office, as New Hampshire District Counsel, and in SBA's Office of General Counsel. He has over 30 years of experience at SBA. He has also served in state and local government and private practice. He is a graduate of Bowdoin College and Vanderbilt University School of Law, and a member of the Massachusetts Bar.
